Simple Machine Poster

will count for one <i>Test Grade</i> and is <i>required</i> . Students will create a poster by dividing a poster into six equal
parts and illustrating each simple machine in each section. The project is due on

- 1. Divide poster into six equal parts.
- 2. Write the names of each of the six simple machines (one in each part).
- 3. Students may choose to fill each simple machine box by drawing simple machines, finding pictures in newspapers, magazines, on the internet, or taking photographs themselves.
- 4. Finally, your child will need to label each individual machine in the boxes.
- 5. Be creative as you would like to be!
