Organisms and Environments



Biosphere



The sum of all living matter on Earth.



Environment



All of the living and nonliving factors in an area.



Abiotic Factors







Factors that are neither living nor produced by living things.



Biotic Factors





Factors that are living or produced by living things.

Ecosystem



A system comprising all the biotic and abiotic factors in an area and all the interactions among them.



Habitat



The place where an organism naturally lives and grows.



Niche



The function or position of an organism or a population within an ecological community.



Species



A group of organisms with similar characteristics that are able to interbreed or exchange genetic material.

Population



A group of interacting individuals of the same species located in the same area.



Community



All of the populations of different species in a particular area.
